What is Grange?

The Grange is a **National Family Fraternity**, a community service organization with a legislative voice and a special interest in agriculture. The fraternal organization is named the **Patrons of Husbandry**.

Membership is attained with the approval of the application, at a business meeting (1st Thursday of the month). Upon approval, the applicants will join grange with a brief Welcoming Ceremony at the next business meeting.

Dues Time Chart

Annual membership dues of \$31.00 will be due on January 1. To join there is a onetime application fee of \$3.00 per person. If you join in:

April, May, June \$15.50/person

July, Aug, Sept \$7.75/person

Oct, Nov, Dec \$3.00 application fee only.
