The Mica Flats Grange has the largest membership in Idaho. It takes 2 steps to join the Grange. Membership is attained with the approval of the application, at the business meeting on the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the month. At the following month's business meeting, the applicants will join with a brief Welcoming Ceremony.

## Dues Time Chart

Annual membership dues of \$29.00 will be due on January 1. To join there is an application fee of \$3.00 per person. If you join in **January, Feb or March** the cost is \$3.00 app fee + \$21.75/ person  
**April, May, June:** \$3.00+\$14.50  
**July, Aug, Sept-**\$3.00 + \$7.25  
**October, November, December:** \$3.00 application fee only.
